Dr Dennis Wong is a Consultant Geriatrician who has particular interests in Dementia, Polypharmacy & Oncology in the elderly. He speaks English, Mandarin, Cantonese and various Asian dialects.

Graduating from Flinders University of South Australia in 1996, Dr Wong completed his training in Geriatric Medicine and Clinical Pharmacology at the Austin & Repatriation Hospital, Heidelberg. He was granted fellowship of the Royal Australian College of Physicians in 2006 and currently consults at North Eastern Rehabilitation Centre in Ivanhoe. Dr Wong is also passionate about the education of the next generation of medical professionals. He has been participating in the Royal Australasian College of Physicians' exams.

One of Dr Wong's practices include visiting Residential Aged Care Facilities stretching from Woodend/Macendon Ranges to NSW/VIC boarder town such as Finley, Berrigan, Tocumwal and Jerilderie where he manages challenging Demented Clients with behavioural issues. He is able to follow these patients up in these areas via teleconferencing or home visit if patients are admitted to hospital in Victoria thus providing a continuum of care throughout.

In the Community, Dr Wong is an advocate for clients with Cognitive Impairment. He believes they can be as productive as the rest of community and are often neglected. These clients are a challenge to their family in many ways and to the society but with specialised Dementia Day Care Centre which adopt an individualised care plan, Dr Wong believes it can assist in many ways. He has recently started this specialised day care in an Asian country.

The Oncology Program at North Eastern Rehabilitation Centre is designed for those with a primary diagnosis of cancer. The program can help you and your family address the physical and psychological needs which may accompany a diagnosis of cancer or as a result of the treatment required. People who would benefit from this program are those who are at the beginning of the cancer rehabilitation journey, to provide physical, occupational, dietetic education and psychological counselling while working collaboratively with your oncologist and surgeon. Post chemotherapy, to improve or maintain physical well-being. Post radiotherapy, to regain strength, mobility and stamina and for those that are deconditioned and want to re-establish their pre-treatment fitness.

Dr Wong currently delivers Specialised Oncology Rehabilitation Services at various locations across Melbourne using a model adopted from United States of America. He works collaboratively with Oncologist Surgeon and Allied Health.
